TO CONSIDER NEXT STEPS FOR USE OF QUEDGELEY SOCIAL CLUB PREMISES POST 31/07/2024 AND TO CONSIDER VIEWS PROVIDED BY RESIDENTS

Cllr Pearce chaired the meeting with the agreement of the council as part of the Futures Group Committee.

Cllr Pearce reminded councillors of the covenant in place for the land on which the Social Club Building sits and reiterated the need to remember the terms of the covenant when considering its future use.

It was agreed that all ideas would be welcome in its future use and ideas should be placed under the following headings:

Youth/Community/Education

Cllr Pearce then invited all councillors to bring forward ideas for the use of the premises, including 2 expressions of interest that had been received by the Clerk and passed onto the councillors prior to the meeting.

Following much discussion, 6 ideas were considered and it was agreed that these would be taken forward to a futures group meeting to discuss whether those ideas would meet the criteria of the covenant as well as being financially viable. It was also agreed that future consultation with the community might be considered if deemed necessary.

Mrs Webster asked councillors to consider a request from the Social Club to purchase the existing CCTV system currently in place for the sum of £50.00. Councillors had no objection in principle and it was agreed to defer this to the next F&GP meeting to be formally agreed.

Mrs Webster asked councillors to consider a request from the Social Club regarding extended access to the building post 31/07/2024. Councillors declined the request in its current format and asked for more specific times to be provided which the council would consider.

It was agreed that the Social Club should pass the keys to the building with immediate effect post 31/07/2024.
