are concerned about ongoing issues with motorbikes and scooters now being
able to access the pathway. Councillors agreed to chase and Mrs Webster
confirmed that she had received correspondence from Gloucestershire County
Council advising they are looking into this however there is a need to ensure that
what is put back in place is compliant to all, including mobility scooters.
